The purpose of a textbook

- to introduce
- to explain
- to teach
- to verify
- to assist

Tutorial

- what
 - introduction to the field/problem
 - explanation of the purpose
 - description of the main idea/foundations
 - description of the possibilities/applications
- how
 - story telling
 - (interactive) video documentary
 - exceptionally: recorded lecture
- when
 - once, on the beginning

(Theory) Explanation

- what
 - how do things work
 - why do they work in such a way
 - how is it used
- how
 - interactive, very short steps
 - explanation, demonstration, question
 - repeating, broadening, accelerating
- when
 - once, on the beginning
 - after long time of passiveness
 - again, if very low results in exercise

Exercising

- what
 - fortifying the new knowledge & skills
 - achieving the required skill level
- how
 - challenges with progressive complexity
 - automated verification of results
 - automated adjustment of complexity
 - comparison with statistics of success
 - referrals to explanation phase
- when
 - each time skills need to be improved

Experimenting

- what
 - broadening of
 - understanding
 - knowledge
 - skills
- how
 - virtual laboratory
 - predefined exercise
 - mandatory
 - recommended
 - bonus
 - free exploration
- when
 - each time skills need to be improved

Referrals

- what
 - reminders
 - quick reference
 - overview (of functions and parameters)
- how
 - lexicon, glossary
 - lookups
 - guides, charts, quick reference
- when
 - often in use

Recepies

- what
 - shortcut for specific tasks
 - in complex environments
- how
 - step by step guide
 - charts, diagrams, photo story
- when
 - at the beginning of usage
 - for specific (complex) tasks

Verification of knowledge

- what
 - verifying possession and understanding of knowledge
 - verifying skills
 - comparison with statistics
- how
 - quiz, test
 - automated verification of results
 - large database of questions
 - algorithm based variation of questions
- when
 - at the end of learning process
 - will be repeated whenever a renewal or improvement of skills is required

- different types of materials
 - in different times
 - for different purposes
- interactive
 - stop, REW, FF, SEEK, search, bookmark
- adjustable
- enchanting
