

Igor S. Pandzic is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Telecommunications, Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing, University of Zagreb, Croatia. Formerly he worked as a Senior Assistant at MIRALab, University of Geneva, Switzerland, where he obtained his PhD in 1998. The same year he worked as visiting scientist at AT&T Labs, USA. In 2001-2002 Igor was a visiting scientist in the Image Coding Group at the University of Linköping, Sweden. Igor received his BSc degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Zagreb in 1993, and MSc degrees from the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (EPFL) and the University of Geneva in 1994 and 1995, respectively. His current research interests focus on virtual characters, and include networked collaborative virtual environments, facial analysis and synthesis, computer generated film production and parallel computing. He published two books and around 50 papers on these topics.
