Ken Klingenstein is Project Director of the Internet2 Middleware Initiative. He coordinates activities intended to build an interoperable middleware infrastructure among I2 members. He also serves on the Senior Staff of Internet2.

Ken is on loan to Internet2 from the University of Colorado at Boulder, where he was Director of Information Technology Services for 14 years, and continues to serve as Chief Technologist for the campus. He has been active in national networking since the beginnings of NSFnet in 1985, serving as a principal in state and regional networking and providing national leadership as Chair of the Federal Networking Council Advisory Committee and giving presentations at the House Subcommittee on Technology, the Kennedy School of Government and the National Research Council, among others. He has also been prominent in higher education, serving on the CAUSE Board, the CREN Board, and the Common Solutions steering group.
