Ivica Milicevic is a senior research consultant at the Work Research Centre, Dublin. His work mainly focused on socio-economic aspects of information technology, such as consideration of cross-national differences in dispositions towards new ways of working arising out of usage of ICTs in the workplace. His work included making major contributions to pan-European research projects in the area of IST – Statistical Indicators for Benchmarking Information Society (SIBIS) and Statistical Indicators for Benchmarking the Progress of European Regions in the Emerging Information Society (BISER), ECaTT (Benchmarking Progress on Electronic Commerce and Teleworking Trends), and the ADAPT project (Management in Support of Teleworking), with prominent inputs in the areas of research design, data analysis, and policy analysis.

The main focus of his current work is in the areas of eHealth and eInclusion. He is currently involved in thematic studies on promoting access to ICTs as means for advancing social inclusion. In his most recent work he has also evaluated the implementation and progress of the Lisbon Agenda in Ireland.
