New technology in our lives

- before: adults got new toy, gradually they'd give it to their children as well (with restrictions)
- now: children grow with internet, gradually their parents join in

Safety and security online

- Safe or secure?
 - "Security" ~ "firewall"
 - "Safety" ~ "content filtering"
 - Anti-virus & anti-spam SW
- Computer and network security is inseparable from internet "safety"
 - Spam carry viruses which explore security flaws and in turn produce spam; both can carry or enable access to unwanted content



National & international cooperation

- CERT network
- "Abuse" services (ISP)
- **EU:** Safer Internet Action Plan
 - Hotlines fighting illegal content (INHOPE)
 - Awareness nodes INSAFE network
 - Tackling illegal and harmful content
 - Filtering & rating
 - Self regulation
 - Promoting a safer environment

- NREN plays a role in educating the internet community
 - Often runs CERT service
- More NREN's are servicing schools in Europe
 - Content hosting (more) reliable sources
 - Reliable email service
 - Efficient virus and spam filtering
 - Videoconferencing, access to MM content
 - Some NREN's register quality content providers
 - Intermediate service level between schools and government

- National awareness node in Slovenia (www.safe.si)
- Aim: raising awareness about internet safety and security in Slovenian society as a whole
- **Target groups**: educators, parents and children
- Partners:

Raising awareness without raising fear

- Raising awareness means public campaigns
- Media love scary stories (so do consumers)
- Need to get to the media...
- Negative effect: fearing and reducing the use of internet and new communication technologies
- Awareness raising should promote positive use
- Need collaboration from all stakeholders
 - Government, NGO's, consumer protection and child welfare organizations, industry...



Who can tell right from wrong?

- Defining "harmful" is impossible (even "illegal" is tough)
 - Taking into account legal and cultural differences
- Protecting individual rights and freedom
- Importance of content evaluation
 - Source criticism
- Content filtering
 - Protection or censorship?
- Know your censor
 - and hope he is a friend or at least responsible

- "Internet safety" just old troubles in a new form
- Frachnology is neither the problem nor the solution
 - It is a tool, can't make social judgements
- Awareness projects inform and promote safer use of online technologies to empower the users
